

Flora Bunting



Inside or out – pretty bunting to decorate your home or garden

Materials

Double knitting yarn - StyleCraft Life DK Shades [2356 Zing](#), [2357 Aqua](#), [2358 Clover](#)
Tension 22 stitches and 30 rows over 10cm x 10cm
4mm knitting needles
Large darning/sewing needle for making up

Instructions

Pennant

Finished size approximately 16cm across, drop 18cm when pressed

Cast on 39 stitches

Rows 1-3 Knit all stitches

Row 4 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Purl 31, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1

Row 5 Purl all (37) stitches

Row 6 Knit 3, Purl 31, Knit 3

Row 7 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 29, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1

Row 8 Knit 3, Purl 29, Knit 3

Row 9 Knit all (35) stitches

Row 10 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Purl 27, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1

Row 11 Knit all (27) stitches

Row 12 Knit 3, Purl 27, Knit 3



- Row 13 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 25, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1
 Row 14 Knit 3, Purl 25, Knit 3
 Row 15 Knit all (31) stitches
- Row 16 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Purl 23, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1
 Row 17 Knit all (29) stitches
 Row 18 Knit 3, Purl 23, Knit 3
- Row 19 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 21, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1
 Row 20 Knit 3, Purl 21, Knit 3
 Row 21 Knit all (27) stitches
- Row 22 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Purl 19, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1
 Row 23 Knit all (25) stitches
 Row 24 Knit 3, Purl 19, Knit 3
- Row 25 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 17, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1
 Row 26 Knit 3, Purl 17, Knit 3
 Row 27 Knit all (23) stitches
- Row 28 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Purl 15, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1
 Row 29 Knit all (21) stitches
 Row 30 Knit 3, Purl 15, Knit 3
- Row 31 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 13, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1
 Row 32 Knit 3, Purl 13, Knit 3
 Row 33 Knit all (19) stitches
- Row 34 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Purl 11, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1
 Row 35 Knit all (17) stitches
 Row 36 Knit 3, Purl 11, Knit 3
- Row 37 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 9, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1
 Row 38 Knit 3, Purl 9, Knit 3
 Row 39 Knit all (15) stitches
- Row 40 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Purl 7, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1

Row 41 Knit all (13) stitches
 Row 42 Knit 3, Purl 7, Knit 3

 Row 43 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 5, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1
 Row 44 Knit 3, Purl 5, Knit 3
 Row 45 Knit all (11) stitches

 Row 46 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Purl 3, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1
 Row 47 Knit all (9) stitches
 Row 48 Knit 3, Purl 3, Knit 3

 Row 49 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 1, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1
 Row 50 Knit 3, Purl 1, Knit 3
 Row 51 Knit all (7) stitches

 Row 52 Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1 (5 stitches)
 Row 53 Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 2 together (3 stitches)

Cast off

Flower

Finished size approximately 10cm diameter when pressed

Petal

Cast on 3 stitches

Row 1 Increase 1 stitch (knit forward and backward into the stitch), Knit 1, Inc 1 (5 stitches)
 Row 2 Purl all stitches
 Row 3 Increase 1 stitch (knit forward and backward into the stitch), Knit 3, Inc 1 (7 stitches)
 Row 4 Purl all stitches
 Row 5 Increase 1 stitch (knit forward and backward into the stitch), Knit 5, Inc 1 (9 stitches)
 Row 6 Purl all stitches
 Row 7 Increase 1 stitch (knit forward and backward into the stitch), Knit 7, Inc 1 (11 stitches)
 Row 8 Purl all stitches

Cut the yarn and slip the petal onto a spare needle

Knit four more petals as above

Slip all five petals onto one needle with right sides facing

- Row 9 Knit 1 row, fastening in loose ends as you go
Row 10 Purl 2 together, repeat to last 1 stitch, Purl 1 (28 stitches)
Row 11 Change yarn colour for flower centre
Knit 2 together, repeat to end (14 stitches)
Row 12 Purl all stitches
Row 13 Knit 2 together to end (7 stitches)
Row 14 Purl all stitches
Row 15 Knit 2 together, repeat to last 1 stitch, knit 1 (4 stitches)

Cut approximately 30cm of yarn and thread onto a large needle and slip through remaining stitches. Pull tight and secure. Sew edges to form a flower shape.

Cord

Cast on three stitches and knit all rows until cord measures 2m (or desired length). Cast off.

Making Up

Sew in all loose ends

Press lightly if necessary - following instructions on yarn ball bands

Attach the flowers to the pennants - a couple of stitches in the centre and at the ends of each petal should hold them fast

Using a darning needle and the yarn in the pennant colour sew the flags to the cord (pictured bunting is spaced at 20cm). Leave sufficient cord at either end for tying up



Ideas and Inspirations

- ❖ This pattern will adapt to any type of yarn – just match your needles to the weight of yarn (needle size required is usually stated on the ball band)
- ❖ Decorate the flags with embroidery stitches, beads or buttons instead of the knitted flowers
- ❖ Applique names or words (Happy Birthday, Congratulations..) onto the flags
- ❖ Add beads or tassels to the ends of the flags
- ❖ Knit in your team or corporate colours
- ❖ Change the yarn colour at intervals to make striped pennants
- ❖ Use ribbon, fabric or tape instead of knitting the cord

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
